Forklift Carriage

Forklift Carriage - There are 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity. Hook type forklift parts tine carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is around thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the blade and the blade eye. Various manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
