Forklift Seats - A strong surface to sit down is known as a seat. These Seats are usually raised above floor level and most seats are supported by four legs and can carry one person. A stool is a seat that does not have any arm rests or a back rest. A seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, whereas a seat with arms only is considered an arm seat. When a seat has connected wheels, it can be called a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is a swing. A permanently connected seat in a theatre or a train is referred to as a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type utilized inside cars and an infant car seat will be a kind of seat specifically meant for young children.

The design of the seat can vary somewhat considerably to accommodate numerous requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs could be decorated with drilled openings, can comprise gaps or low backs for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back can be designed as an included headrest by way of extending the height above the occupant's head. Seats may be constructed along with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool which is intended to be used as a movable footrest. At times the ottoman could be connected to a glider chair with swing arms, allowing the ottoman to rock back and forth with the glider similar to a rocking chair together with a built-in footrest.

Covers for seats are temporary fabric wraps providing protections against wear or to offer better aesthetics. Presently available there are a large array of seat covers from neoprene to leather. More formal materials could be rented for events like for example weddings to be able to improve the decoration. Several seat covers have decorative seat ties or ribbons connected to be tied at the back of the seat in a ribbon or decorative knot. Several folks utilize customized clear plastic furniture covers to protect their pricey sofas and seats.

Seat pads are cushions meant for seats, usually decorative; they may also be used in vehicles to add to the drivers' height. Orthopaedic backrests provide support for the back, frequently in lower spine or lumbar area. A few producers have their seat pad designs patented and are recognized by some medical associations. Some of the newer car seats available are equipped along with built-in and adjustable lumbar supports to provide additional comfort to riders as well as drivers of the vehicle.
